Synopsis

What would you do if someone accused you of being a terrorist? Mild-mannered romance novelist Nathan Hathaway's great-great grandfather was a fire-breathing Confederate general who once led a march on Washington, but he never dreamed that he might be destined to follow in his ancestor's footsteps.

Then one night a heavily armed force of government operatives descend on Nathan's mid-west homestead, taking him and his wife Edie hostage. Their leader, a fanatical agent named Cairn, tells Nathan a bizarre story. It seems a top-secret experiment in "remote viewing" using tachyons, exotic particles that travel backwards in time, has produced evidence that suggests the U.S. government will be overthrown by a violent revolution within a few years. Cairn shows Nathan photographs of a future Washington D.C. in which a massive statue of the conquering general stands amidst the ruins of the Capitol building. The name on the base of the statue is clearly visible: Nathan Hathaway. Terrified by the implications, someone in the Washington establishment has given the order to terminate every Nathan Hathaway in the continental United States.

But for Cairn this is more than just a mission; it's personal. A militia bomb, whose components have been traced to a nearby gun shop, killed his family. He believes Nathan knows those responsible, and wants names. When Nathan refuses to cooperate, Cairn's methods get rough.
